## GOALS AND PHILOSOPHY

The Fine Arts Academy of Second Baptist Church, under the umbrella of The Music Ministry, is an outreach tool that:

- Provides quality instruction in the arts in a safe, positive Christian environment
- Aids in the development of students in the areas of self esteem, skill, social interaction and accomplishment and
- Assists in meeting the spiritual needs of students
- Private study is offered in piano, voice, strings, violin, cello, woodwinds and guitar

## INSTRUMENT POLICY

Students are responsible for providing their own instruments and should be able to practice on instruments that facilitate progress. The director and instructors will be glad to recommend dealers for new, used or rental instruments.

## LESSONS AND SCHEDULING

Qualified Christian professional instructors on the premises of Second Baptist Church will teach all Academy lessons. Lessons are taught in 30 minute, 45 minute, and 60 minute blocks and are offered Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday afternoons. During the enrollment period, students will be assigned an instructor, lesson day and time. Every effort will be made to accommodate requests. Once a lesson time is determined, the student will be contacted to confirm participation and other specifics.

## REGISTRATION

To begin the enrollment process, new students must contact the program director, complete the registration form and submit with the registration fee.

*When a student is enrolled he/she is committing to an entire school year of study.*

## TUITION

An annual \$35 non-refundable registration fee must accompany the enrollment form. This fee is in addition to the overall tuition costs. One-half of the semester tuition is due by August 1<sup>st</sup> and the remainder is due by October 30<sup>th</sup>. Costs are:

\$30.00 for 30 minute lesson; \$40.00 for 45 minute lesson; \$55.00 for 60 minute lesson.

Suggested starting grades:

Piano - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade

Voice - 10<sup>th</sup> grade

Strings - Preschool

Violin - Preschool

Woodwinds - 3<sup>rd</sup> grade

Guitar - 1<sup>st</sup> grade
